Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) makes it a tradition to mandatorily collect feedback from stakeholders- students and alumni on quality-related institutional processes. With quality sustenance as its focus, the IQAC of the college has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the various stakeholders through a structured rating based feedback form. We have designed a special feedback form on quality-related institutional processes. This is done by the Feedback Committee. They collect and analyze the feedback received and make suggestions to appropriate bodies so as to initiate the action for improvement. In past it used to be collected manually, but shifting the institute on technology, it has been made system supported & online.

Objective:

This feedback is collected and the data was analyzed to provide valuable insight into the stakeholders- students and alumni perception about the quality-related institutional processes.

Methodology:

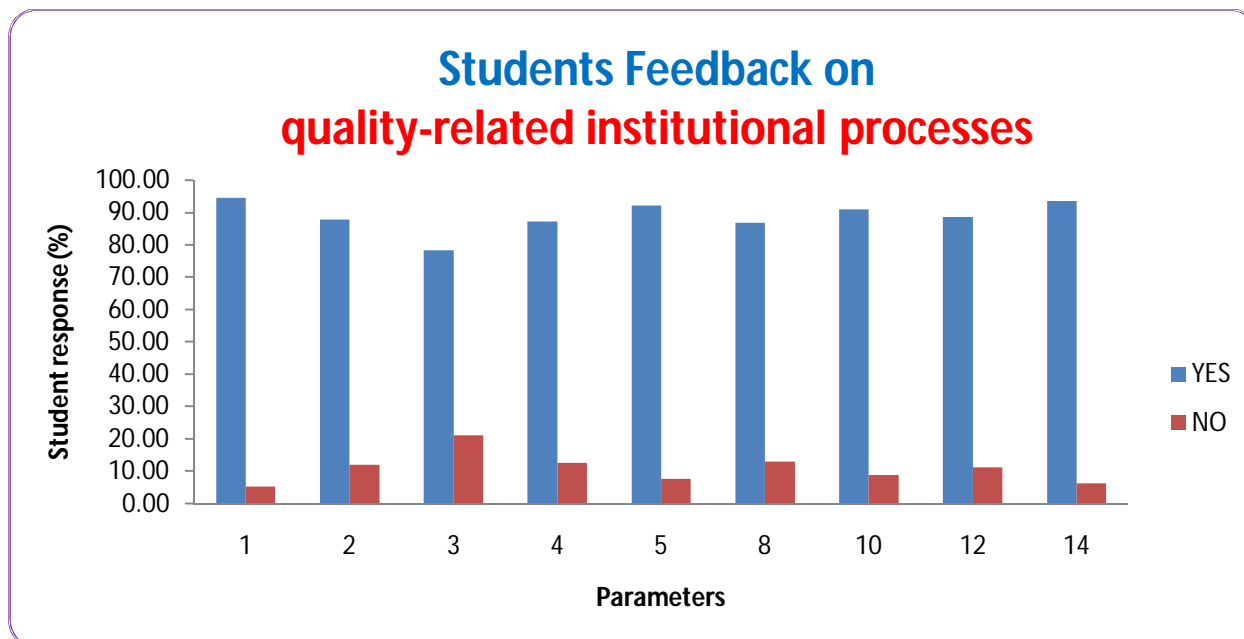
Feedback on quality-related institutional processes is collected from stakeholders- students and alumni on quality-related institutional processes by manually. It is collected and brought to the IQAC for its analysis. The Statistical data is handed over to the Feedback committee. The data get compiled and analyzed by the members associated with the committee. It then goes for deliberation to the IQAC, CDC and Governing Body Further suggestions are incorporated by departments, college development committee (CDC) and governing body. The decisions taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated. Meetings were held at the IQAC level, CDC and Governing Body to implement the suggestions in the feedback. Finally, analysis report and action taken report on collected feedback on quality-related institutional processes from stakeholders- students and alumni are made available on college website.

FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS

For the academic year 2022-23, feedback on quality-related institutional processes was taken from the students from program, B.Com and B.Sc. through manually forms. The analysis of students' feedback through 16 parameters on quality-related institutional processes is presented as under:

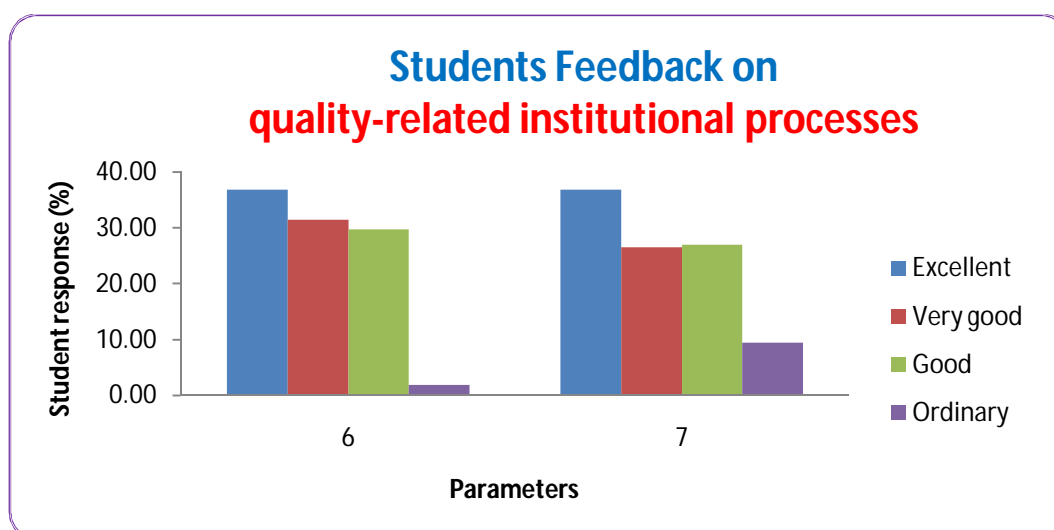

Feedback Analysis Report



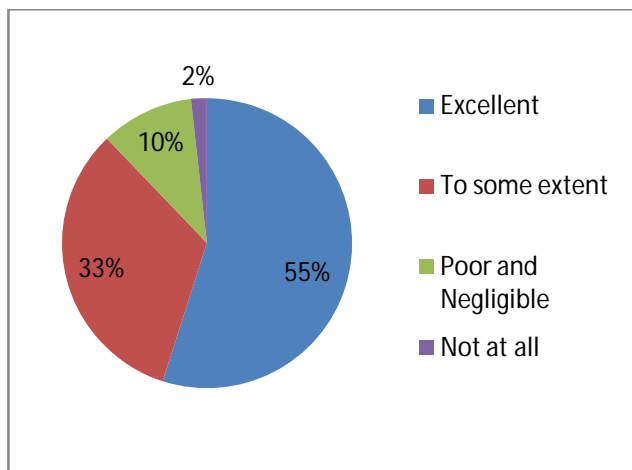
For the above parameters, it can be seen from the graph that more than 88 % of students are rating the positive response. On the other side near about 10 % students are yet unhappy with the quality-related institutional processes. Also few students felt that there is no sufficient and well maintained sanitary blocks. The overall feedback from the students on the above parameters shows that students are well satisfied with the facilities and efforts taken by the institute.

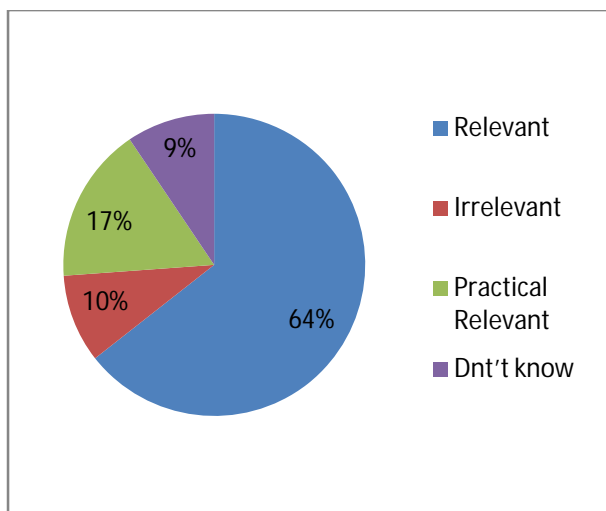

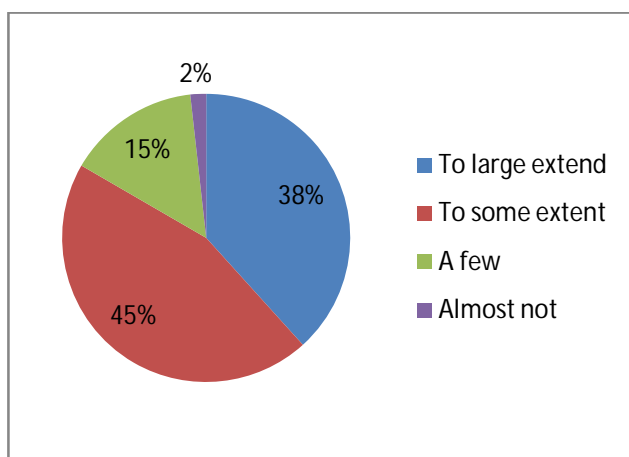
It can be seen from the graph that more than 85 % of students are rating the “Excellent” or “To some extent” for the enough scope for extra-curricular activities in the college.

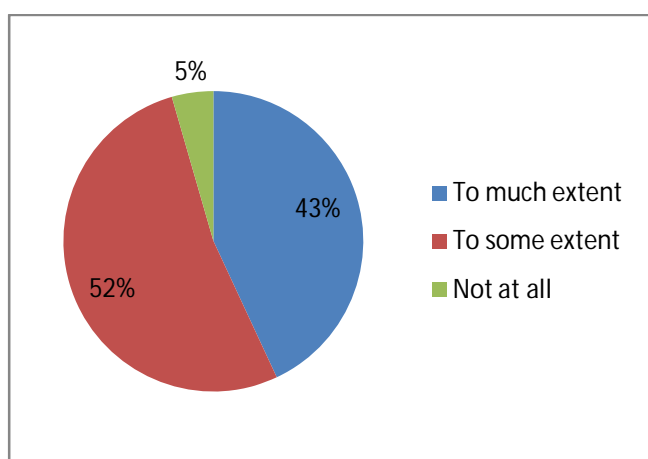
It can be seen from the graph that more than 80 % of students are rating the “Relevant” or “Practical Relevant ” is the curriculum prescribed for their career.

Suggestions from students

1. Most of the students suggest start to new UG and PG courses including B.C.A., B.Sc. (Computer, M.Sc. (Chemistry), M.B.A., M.C.A. and others.
2. There is no Bus facility to reach the college.

4. There should be coaching classes for competitive exams like UPSC and MPSC.
5. There should be Auditorium in college.
6. There should be bike parking facility for male students.
7. Kept the classrooms always clean.
8. Made available the sufficient Computers and Digital teaching technology in the college.
9. Made available the sufficient Space in Ladies room.
10. Start the NCC for both male and female students.
